

RISING SENIORS...You have the chance to paint your very own RESERVED PARKING SPOT for the 2022-2023 school year!

How to Register

If you are a class of 2023 school year student and wish to obtain a reserved painted parking spot, you must complete the following steps to be considered for approval:

- Download the **Painted Parking Spot Packet** from www.pacehighschoolptso.com or pick-up from the PHS Front Desk beginning Monday, April 25, 2022.
- Pay an **ONLINE ONLY** registration fee of \$100.
 - The registration and payment link will be active on www.pacehighschoolptso.com from May 16 – May 20, 2022 only.
 - This fee includes a reserved parking decal, choice of parking spot among the available reserved spots (first come first serve), and permission to paint your parking spot (once the design is approved). Proceeds from the \$100.00 registration fee will be invested by PTSO in projects directly benefiting the school, as well as portions to the PHS Athletics Department and the Senior Class Grad Night Fund.
- **Completion and submission of 1) Painted Parking Spot Agreement & 2) Senior Painted Parking Design Request**, to the PHS Front Office for administrative approval by May 20, 2022. You will be notified of your approval via email from the online form.

Parking Space Assignment

Students are highly encouraged to register online as soon as the link becomes available if there is a desire to obtain a specific reserved spot. Priority of space selection will be determined by order of registration and payment submission. No review will be done until all forms are completed. Failure to submit all paperwork by the deadline will result in a release of a reserved parking spot, and a refund of the registration fee. This will be the only opportunity to reserve a painted parking spot for the 2022-2023 school year.

Painting Dates and Times

Eligible students will be painting their parking spots only on the dates below:

Painted Parking Spot Rules

1. You MUST purchase/provide your own paint and brushes to use to decorate your parking spot. **WATER-BASED EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT is the only type of paint that can be used.** No spray, reflective, fluorescent, interior or craft paint is permitted. (Consider sharing with others)



PHS PTSO has negotiated with Sherwin Williams in Pace (Hwy 90) to offer a PHS student discount for the appropriate paint type and supplies beginning in July! *Info will be posted on the class page.* It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that paint be purchased at this location, as the associates will be familiar with required paint types, be able to answer specific questions, and provide discounted kits.

Painted Parking Spot Rules (continued)

2. Students MUST clean spills and discard all unused materials. NO PAINT OR TRASH OF ANY KIND MAY BE DISPOSED OF ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. STUDENTS ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR PAINT DISPOSAL OFF-CAMPUS.
3. The assigned Reserved Parking Decal must be visible on the vehicle associated with the spot.
4. Students must not paint over the parking spot number, nor paint on the parking spot lines, and it must be school appropriate and follow the below guidelines.
5. **HAVE FUN!!!** Allowing students to paint their parking spots improves school pride and camaraderie among peers. Students can create their own unique piece of the school in their final year. **We encourage students to express themselves through POSITIVE artwork.**
6. **All designs must be pre-approved.** The painted Parking Spot Packet is due no later than Friday, May 20, 2022, prior to the final bell. A copy of the design for your parking spot MUST be drawn, in color, on the attached form; we will keep this, so make a copy for yourself. Designs must be approved by PHS administration. Once reviewed, you will receive an email letting you know if your design has been accepted or if any changes need to be made.
7. You must follow the approved design EXACTLY on painting day - NO CHANGES ALLOWED.

Prohibited Themes/Content

Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Administration. Disciplinary and Criminal actions may be taken. If this happens, you will not only be forfeiting your right to a parking spot and/or to drive on campus but you will also forfeit any monies collected.



- No political or potentially divisive content/imagery
- No offensive language, pictures, or symbols
- No negative or rude language (BE NICE)
- No double-entendre's (double meanings)
- You may use YOUR name. If you want to use a nickname it must be approved (*a boyfriend's or girlfriend's name is NOT allowed*)

Painting Day!

Before you begin painting, check-in at the PHS PTSO table located by the Media Center. You must have your paint approved at this time and a copy of your signed approved design. A reminder that students MUST follow this design EXACTLY.

Suggested Materials, Tips & Hints

Water-based exterior paint, including primer paint/base coat for concrete	Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans	Paint pans or plastic containers for water
Paint brushes and/or rollers	Chalk to sketch design	Paint and Brushes
Blue painters' tape (4" wide)	Stencil (if applicable)	People to help
Broom to sweep spot before painting	Old cloths or paper towels	A bag for your trash
Sunshade, sunscreen, umbrellas, sunglasses, hats, canopy tent	Water, Snacks (Concessions will be available!)	Lawn chairs, stool, and/or a towel to sit on





